

ADDITIONAL SUBORDINATE DISTRICT COUNCIL COURT

2. **Additional Subordinate District Council Court**—For the trial of suits and cases within the Syiemship, Lyngdohship, Sirdarship, Wahadadarship not triable by village courts to be presided over by the Syiem, Lyngdoh, Sirdar, Wahadadar, as the case may be with such number of Myntris or customary elders. In civil cases its pecuniary jurisdiction is unlimited and in criminal cases it can exercise powers as may be invested as defined in Chapter III of the Cr.P.C. It hears appeals from the decision of the village courts both civil and criminal. In civil cases its procedure is guided by the spirit but not bound by the letter of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 as amended. In criminal cases its procedure is guided by the spirit of the Code of Criminal Procedures. 1973 as amended uptodate.
